

- 1. In 1860, "Blind Tom" Wiggins, African American autistic savant and piano prodigy, was the first African American to perform here.
- 2. This Act was signed by Abraham Lincoln on April 16, 1862 to abolish slavery in the District of Columbia.
- 5. A civil rights organization in the United States, it was formed in 1909 as an interracial endeavor to advance justice for African Americans by a group including W. E. B. Du Bois, Mary White Ovington, Moorfield Storey and Ida B. Wells.
- 7. This was the first African American owned and operated newspaper published in the United States.
- 10. Sarah Goode was the first African American woman to receive a patent for this invention.
