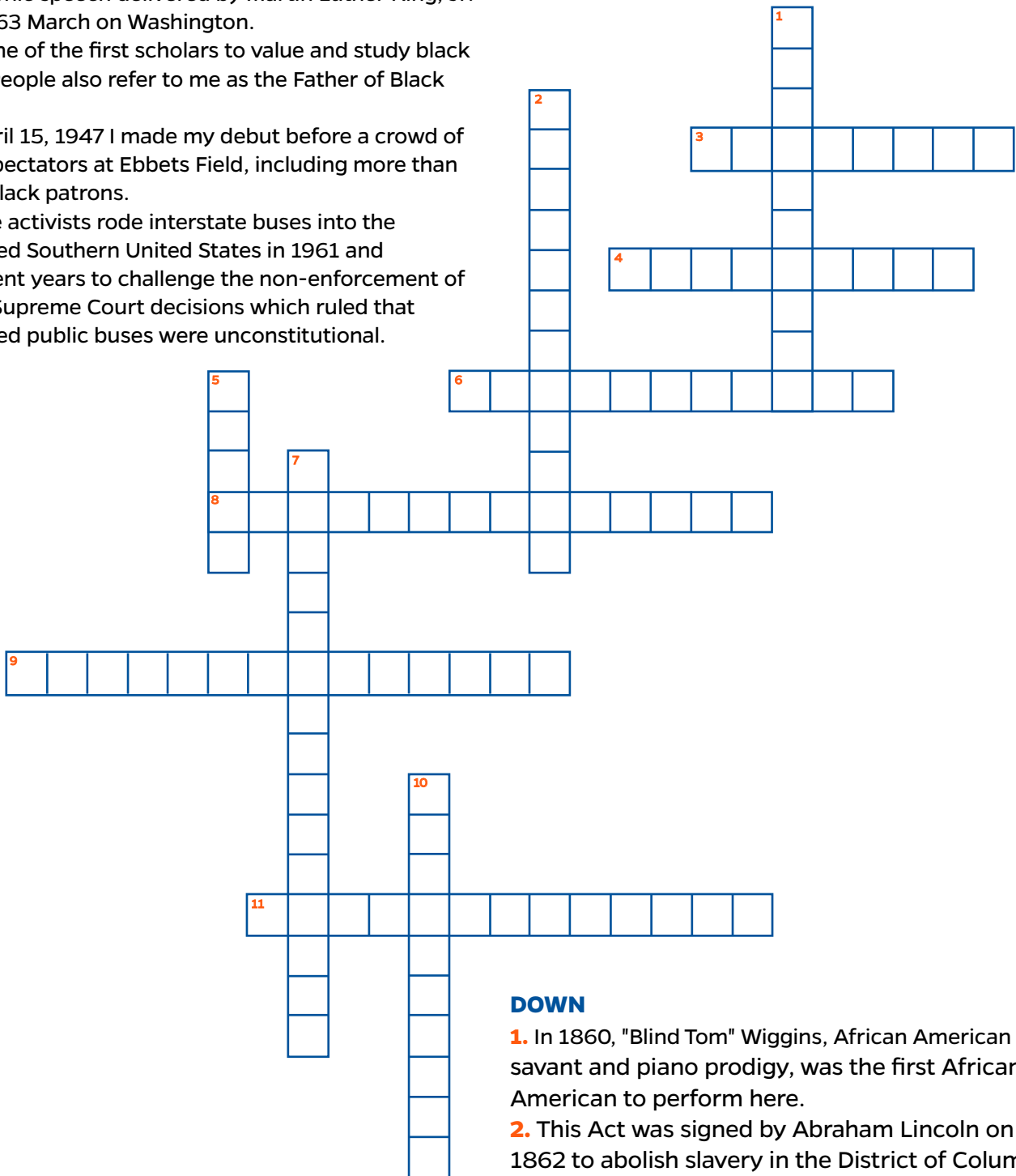


## ACROSS

1. In 1860, "Blind Tom" Wiggins, African American autistic savant and piano prodigy, was the first African American to perform here.
2. This Act was signed by Abraham Lincoln on April 16, 1862 to abolish slavery in the District of Columbia.
5. A civil rights organization in the United States, it was formed in 1909 as an interracial endeavor to advance justice for African Americans by a group including W. E. B. Du Bois, Mary White Ovington, Moorfield Storey and Ida B. Wells.
7. This was the first African American owned and operated newspaper published in the United States.
10. Sarah Goode was the first African American woman to receive a patent for this invention.
